We welcome proposals from representatives of community resources; experienced youth service professionals, mental health professionals, and train-the-trainer programs. Workshop session length will be up to 60 minutes for 10-15 people.

Presentations should support participants to increase knowledge in the following areas:

- The challenges that face our First Nation Youth
- Mental Health issues
- Genealogy/family tree
- Traditional ways of healthy living – connectedness with tradition and culture
- Disclosure
- Anger Management
- Leadership
- Grief and Loss
- Cultural safety
- FASD
- Child and Welfare services – i.e. what is expected of foster parents? What is expected of Parent visits?

Proposal review process:

The planning committee will consider the following factors in reviewing proposals:

1. Relevance to the educational interests of Saik'uz Elder/knowledge Holders.
2. Integration with other presentations on the agenda for the event.
3. Expertise and speaking experience of the proposed presenter(s).
4. Thorough descriptions of the content of the presentation.
