## **CONSTRUCTION UPDATES**

- Steady progress is being made, with work advancing toward upcoming visible completion milestones.
- Construction at Tachick Lake advanced significantly through the interior mechanical phase.
- Archwest and Equity crews have advanced pipe insulation, duct wrap, and plumbing rough-in activities within the west residence penthouse.
- Mechanical systems across penthouse areas are now approaching readiness for final inspection and the next stage of interior finishing.
- In early February, CSFS conducted a three-day think tank session to realign governance, risk management, budget reconciliation, and construction oversight strategies.
