Project Overview: The Tachick Lake Healing Centre is a year-round, land-based substance-use recovery program designed to uphold the dignity, rights, and wellbeing of First Nations people in northern British Columbia.

The Centre provides a full continuum of care, including detox services, cultural and clinical treatment, and aftercare supports that keep families safely together whenever possible

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

- Steady progress is being made, with work advancing toward upcoming visible completion milestones.
- Envelope construction is actively progressing across most facilities.
- Mechanical contractors are actively insulating piping
- Pipe insulation has been completed for all installed piping on site.
