Her responsibilities include the coordination of the Carrier Sekani Child and Family Well-being Law being drafted under the Federal Child Welfare Act. She is the coordinating lead for community involvement in the development of the Act, and is the lead on the Technical Drafting Committee.

She is responsible for overseeing the drafting of the Act, review and final assent by the Whu Neeh Nee Council. Stephanie leads partnerships with the Crown and the Province for Jurisdiction and is a pivotal senior manager responsible for service delivery under the Jurisdiction Framework. Stephanie and her team will work with the member Nations and all departments under CSFS to ensure protocols regarding the inherent authority of each Nation to care for their own is respected.

Besides her role at CSFS, Stephanie is a mom to two adult children living in Vancouver, and she manages Raysong Farm and loves every minute of it! She cares for goats, lambs, chickens, ducks, rabbits, horses, and the farm's namesake – a rooster called "Sully"!
